

Sock Monkey Head Pin

Supplies Needed:

- 9" x 12" craft cuts Kunin Corduroy: Sandstone, Walnut
- 9" x 12" craft cuts Kunin Classicfelt: Red, White
- Wiggly Eyes
- Ellison Super Star Die Cut Machine
- Die Cutting Pads

- Laura Kelly's Sock Monkey Die from Ellison/Sizzix
- Pin Brooch Clasp
- Felt Glue
- Hot Glue Gun and Hot Glue Sticks
- Scissors

How To Make It

- 1. Using the Laura Kelly Sock Monkey die from Sizzix/Ellison, a Sizzix/Ellison Die Cutting Machine and cutting pads, cut out all of the monkey pieces and accessories that you'd like to use.
 - -2 Monkey heads, one in Corduroy Sandstone and one in Corduroy Walnut. Cut off the neck and body of the Walnut monkey. Cut an oval out of the Sandstone.
 - -A red oval piece for the back larger than the opening in the head.
- 2. Glue all of the pieces together, placing the red oval on the back of the monkey head.
- 3. Add the eyes and the accessories.
- 4. Using a hot glue gun, glue the pin brooch clasp to the back of the monkey head.
