



Unicorn Mask

Supplies Needed:

- 9" x 12" craft cuts of Kunin Classic Felt: White (2 for mask)
- 9" x 12" craft cut of Kunin Corduroy Felt: White or Light Pink (for the horn)
- Felt Scraps in Assorted Colors
- Felt Glue
- String or Ribbon

How To Make It

1. Using the Forest Woodland Mask Die (Laura Kelly for Ellison/Sizzix), cut out two white masks.
2. Glue them together to get a double thickness.
3. Cut a large triangle for a horn, roll it and glue the ends shut.
4. Attach it to the mask with glue.
5. Add flowers and such with other felt scraps. There is a flower and a leaf in the die.
6. Tie string in the holes at either end to create a way to tie the mask to a head.
