

Earth Day: Save Energy Sign

Supplies

- 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Yellow
- 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in White
- 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Silver Grey
- 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Black
- 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Premium in Royal Blue
- 1 – Bottle of Puff Paint in White
(Shown is Tulip® Beads in a Bottle in White)
- 1 – Bottle of Puff Paint in Grey
(Shown is Tulip® Beads in a Bottle in Grey)
- 1 – Wooden Dowel
- 1 – Skein of Twine in White/Black
- 1 – Sizzix Big Shot Die Cutting Machine
- 1 – Sizzix XL Die Set: Fresh Blossoms Alphabet by Stephanie Ackerman
- 1 – Aleene's Turbo Tacky Glue
- 1 – Pair of Scissors



Directions

1. Begin by hand cutting the light bulb/base for your sign.
TIP: Always cut larger and then trim down. (Figure A)
2. Add your puff paint accents and let the pieces dry.
(Figure B)
3. Die cut all of the letters for the sign phrases using your
Sizzix Big Shot with the Sizzix XL Die Set: Fresh Blossoms

Alphabet. Arrange them and then adhere them to your 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Yellow. You can use tacky glue to adhere them – tacky glue works better because it is easier to control on the die cut letters.
TIP: Be sure on placement before your glue down your letters. (Figure C)

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Directions (continued)

4. To create the banner sign, adhere first the twine and then the wooden dowel to the top of the felt using tacky glue. The dowel will provide additional support to the sign. (Figure D)
5. Hang these signs in spots that will remind everyone to turn off lights when leaving a room. The sign is a fun way to celebrate Earth Day and provide a way to teach kids about conservation too!
