

#1 Dad Keychain Katie Berry

Level: Beginner + Basic Sewing

Time: 1 Hour

Supplies

- 1 12"x18" Craft Cut of Kunin[®] Classic in Lagoon
- 1 Skein of White Embroidery Floss
- 1 Needle
- 1 Cutting Mat
- 1 Rotary Cutter
- 1 Cutting Ruler
- 1 Pair of Scissors
- 1 Pair of Pliers
- 1 Dritz[®] Mark-B-Gone[™] Marker

Key Fob Hardware

Directions

- 1. Cut a 1.25"x7" strip of felt.
- Fold the strip in half and use the marker to draw your letters, making sure to leave enough space at the top to place the key fob hardware. (Figure A)
- Using a needle and embroidery floss, stitch over the markings using a split stitch. Blanket stitch around the outside connecting the front and back of the felt. (Figure B)
- **4.** Place the key fob hardware on the end of the felt. Using a pair of pliers, close the clamp. TIP: Place a piece of felt over the clamp before using the pliers so that it will not scratch the hardware.


