

# #1 Dad Keychain

**Time:** 1 Hour

## Supplies

- 1 – 12"x18" Craft Cut of Kunin® Classic in Lagoon
- 1 – Skein of White Embroidery Floss
- 1 – Needle
- 1 – Cutting Mat
- 1 – Rotary Cutter
- 1 – Cutting Ruler
- 1 – Pair of Scissors
- 1 – Pair of Pliers
- 1 – Dritz® Mark-B-Gone™ Marker
- Key Fob Hardware



## Directions

1. Cut a 1.25"x7" strip of felt.
2. Fold the strip in half and use the marker to draw your letters, making sure to leave enough space at the top to place the key fob hardware. (Figure A)
3. Using a needle and embroidery floss, stitch over the markings using a split stitch. Blanket stitch around the outside connecting the front and back of the felt. (Figure B)
4. Place the key fob hardware on the end of the felt. Using a pair of pliers, close the clamp. TIP: Place a piece of felt over the clamp before using the pliers so that it will not scratch the hardware.
