

# Baseball Zipper Pencil Pouch

**Level:** Beginner + Basic Sewing

**Time:** 1-2 Hours

## Supplies

½ yard from bolt of Kunin Premium in White

1 – 9" Zipper in White

1 – Cutting Mat

1 – Rotary Cutter

1 – Cutting Ruler

1 – Bottle Red Fabric Paint

1 – Black Marker

White Thread

Pins



## Directions

1. Cut two 9.5" x 7" rectangles of the white felt. (Figure A)
2. Pin the zipper to one of the 9.5" sides. Sew the zipper in place. TIP: Make sure your zipper is face up. (Figure B)
3. Sew the other rectangle to the other side of the zipper. (Figure C)
4. Now it's time to sew the pouch closed. Put the two sides together with the zipper on the inside. This essentially looks like the pouch is inside out. Sew the three edges together. TIP: Make sure to unzip the zipper a few inches so that you can turn the pouch right side out. (Figure D)
5. Once you are done sewing up the edges, turn the pouch right side out through the zipper. (Figure E)
6. Using a black marker, draw two curved lines.
7. Then using the fabric paint, add the V's to resemble the stitches of a baseball. I only used the fabric paint on one side of the pouch but you could add it to the other side too once the front side dries. (Figure F)
8. Let the fabric paint dry and then it's ready for the kiddos to use.
