

Gnome Ornament

Supplies

- 1 9" x 12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Pirate Green
- 1 9" x 12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Red
- 1 9" x 12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Sandstone
- 1 5" x 5" piece of Kunin Plush in White
- 1 Pair of Scissors
- 1 Hot Glue Gun with Glue Sticks
- 1 Small Pompom in Off White or Cream
- 1 Skein of Green Embroidery Floss
- **1** Embroidery Needle
- 2 Small Brads in Black

Stuffing



Directions


- **1.** Cut out the pieces of the pattern. Pin the paper pieces to the felt and cut them out.
- **2.** Place the two body pieces together. Starting at one corner, whipstitch them together leaving bottom open for stuffing. (Figure A)
- **3.** Stuff the body and stitch closed. (Figure B)
- **4.** Align the hat piece with the body and attach using the hot glue gun.
- **5.** Position the face piece flush against the bottom of the hat and glue down.

- **6.** Attach the beard, gluing it down around the face and leaving the bottom loose.
- 7. Glue the pompom nose in place.
- **8.** Cut the sticks from the brads and glue them in place. (Figure C)
- **9.** With a small piece of embroidery floss and needle, create a loop to hang the ornament. (Figure D)


